# 1.4.4 - Does your university as a body participate in policy making at local, regional, national and/or global level to implement programmes and policies to end poverty in all its dimensions?

Azerbaijan State Oil and Industry University (ASOIU) acknowledges the essential role that higher-education institutions play in shaping evidence-based policies for sustainable development and poverty eradication. In alignment with the United Nations SDGs ASOIU integrates education, research, and civic engagement to influence social and economic policies at local, regional, national, and global levels.

Through the Sustainable Development Center and institutional collaboration with governmental bodies, international networks, and NGOs, ASOIU acts not only as an educational institution but as a policy-making stakeholder in promoting inclusive growth and sustainable livelihoods.

#### **Local Level – Social Inclusion and Educational Access**

At the local level, ASOIU undertakes targeted measures that directly alleviate poverty by removing barriers to education and supporting disadvantaged groups:

- Tuition Fee Exemption Scheme for Low-Income and Vulnerable Groups ASOIU exempts tuition fees
  for internally displaced persons (IDPs), children of martyrs, orphans, students with disabilities, and those
  from low-income families. This policy aligns university practice with Azerbaijan's social-protection
  legislation.
- Student Support and Welfare Initiatives The Student Trade Union Committee manages dormitory
  housing, affordable meals, and the StudentPlus Card programme providing discounts on essential
  services.



• Community Engagement Projects – The "Empowering the Smiles of the Future" initiative mobilises volunteers to assist underprivileged children in Baku through mentoring and creative education.

## National / Regional Level - Research-Based Policy Engagement

ASOIU contributes to Azerbaijan's national poverty-reduction and sustainable-development strategies through policy consultation, evidence-based research, and partnership programmes:

- Integration with State Policy ASOIU's financial-aid and inclusion policies mirror government social-support systems for IDPs, war-affected families, and persons with disabilities, thus acting as an institutional extension of national policy.
- Campaigners Project Partnership ASOIU serves as a national partner in the EU-supported Campaigners
  Project, which empowers youth to advocate for social inclusion, responsible consumption, and community
  resilience. The project produces actionable recommendations for social-policy reform shared with local
  municipalities and national stakeholders.
