

11.4.5 - Does your university as a body provide affordable housing for students?

The Azerbaijan State Oil and Industry University (ASOIU) provides modern, comfortable, and inclusive dormitory facilities designed to ensure a safe, supportive, and sustainable living environment for its students. These residences serve as a key element of ASOIU's student life infrastructure, combining convenience, academic support, and community well-being.

Main ASOIU Dormitory

ASOIU's main student dormitory complex contains a total of 250 rooms, offering accommodation for both undergraduate and postgraduate students.

- 150 rooms are designed for four residents each, promoting a communal and collaborative living atmosphere.
- 100 rooms are configured for two residents, providing additional privacy and study-focused space for senior or international students.

Each room is fully furnished with beds, desks, wardrobes, and study lamps, providing students with a comfortable and functional environment conducive to academic success and personal growth.

Partner Dormitory

In addition to the main facility, ASOIU also maintains a working agreement with an external student residence that supports the accommodation needs of a growing student population.

- This partner dormitory includes over 600 rooms, each designed for four occupants, offering housing for both local and international students.
- The collaboration ensures affordable, high-quality housing close to the main campus, thereby minimizing commuting distances and supporting sustainable urban mobility.



Facilities and Amenities

Both dormitories are equipped with a wide range of amenities to ensure a holistic student experience:

- Library and Study Rooms: Quiet zones for reading, research, and academic group work.



- Indoor and Outdoor Gyms: Spaces dedicated to physical health, recreation, and student wellness.



- Shared Kitchens: Each floor includes modern, well-equipped kitchens that allow students to prepare meals independently.
- Common Lounges: Comfortable areas for socializing, cultural exchange, and informal meetings.



- Laundry and Maintenance Services: Easily accessible washing facilities and regular maintenance support.
- High-Speed Wi-Fi: Campus-wide internet access enabling seamless study and communication.
- 24/7 Security: Controlled entry systems and security personnel to maintain a safe environment.



Location and Connectivity

Both dormitories are situated within close proximity to the main ASOIU campus, ensuring easy access to classrooms, laboratories, dining halls, and administrative offices. Students also benefit from university shuttle services and nearby public transportation routes, reducing travel time and supporting sustainable commuting practices in line with ASOIU's environmental commitments.

Community and Sustainability

ASOIU's dormitories foster a vibrant, multicultural student community. Regular activities such as orientation sessions, sports events, and cultural evenings help residents build lasting friendships and a sense of belonging.

Sustainability measures are integrated into daily dormitory operations — including energy-efficient lighting, water conservation systems, waste segregation, and green open spaces for relaxation. These initiatives reflect ASOIU's broader mission to create a healthy, eco-friendly, and inclusive campus environment.

Application and Access

All full-time students, especially first-year and international students, are eligible to apply for ASOIU dormitory accommodation.

Applications are handled through the Student Affairs Department, with allocations based on academic status, need, and availability.
