## 16.3.1 — Expert Advice to Government

Azerbaijan State Oil and Industry University (ASOIU) plays a recognized and continuous role in supporting national governance, policy development, and public sector modernization through both its faculty expertise and alumni network.

This institutional impact is evidenced by:

## 1. Institutional-Level Contributions

- ASOIU's academic staff regularly participate in national and ministerial working groups, advisory councils, and strategic commissions related to:
  - Energy policy, digital transformation, and renewable technologies (collaboration with the *Ministry of Energy* and *SOCAR*).
